

Privacy Policy

M.S.M.W.V. Dutch Mountains attaches a lot of value to protecting personal information. In this Privacy Policy, we will give clear information on what we do with your personal information.

We do everything we can within our reach to protect your privacy and therefore treat your personal information with caution. M.S.M.W.V. Dutch Mountains always follows the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). This means that we:

- Process your personal information only for the causes for which you gave it to us, these causes are stated in this Privacy Policy;
- Only process the minimal amount of information that is needed for the stated cause;
- Ask for your explicit agreement for processing your personal information;
- Have taken sufficient measures to ensure the safety of your personal information;
- Do not give your personal information to third parties, unless this is needed for performing the act for which you provided us with your information initially;
- Are aware of the laws and rights concerning your personal information and respect those.

M.S.M.W.V. Dutch Mountains is responsible for processing your personal information. In case you have any questions or concerns considering the processing of your data, you are always free to contact us through our contact information, which is stated at the end of this document.

Processing members' personal information

Personal information of the members of M.S.M.W.V. Dutch Mountains is only processed for the following purpose(s):

- Administrative purpose;
- Financial purpose;
- Competitive purpose;
- Communicative purpose;
- Invitations.

The foundation of this personal information is:

- The subscription form

For the above-mentioned purpose(s) M.S.M.W.V. Dutch Mountains can ask you the next personal data:

- First name;
- Infix;
- Last name;
- Phone number;
- E-mail address;
- Sex;
- IBAN;
- Studentnumber (I-number);

Your personal data will be provided by M.S..W.V Dutch Mountains for the purpose of the above-mentioned purposes(s) for the period:

- During the term of the agreement and then only in the financial administration for a maximum of 7 years.

Processing members' personal information for the newsletter

Personal data of subscribers of the newsletter will be provided by M.S.M.W.V. Dutch Mountains for the following purpose(s):

- Informing the person per newsletter.

The basis for this personal information is:

- The consent statement;

For the above-mentioned purpose(s) M.S.M.W.V. Dutch Mountains can ask you the next personal data:

- First name;
- Infix;
- Last name;
- E- mail adres;

Your personal data will be provided by M.S..W.V Dutch Mountains for the purpose of the above-mentioned purposes(s) for the period:

- During the period that you are registered.

Providing to third parties

We could provide the information that has been given to us to third parties in case this is necessary for the implementation of the above described purposes:

We make use of third parties in the following cases:

- taking care of the financial administration

- taking care of newsletters and invitations
- offering of a website
- offering of competitive sport

We will never give personal information to third parties that have not agreed to a processing contract. With these third parties (processors) we will make the necessary agreements to secure your personal information. Furthermore we will not provide personal information (given by you) to other parties, unless it is obligatory and allowed by law. For example, in case of an investigation the police can ask personal information from our association. In such a case we have to collaborate and we are obliged to give (personal) information. In addition we can provide personal information to third parties if you give us a written agreement.

Within the EU

We do not provide any personal data to parties based outside of the EU

Storage period

M.S.M.W.V. Dutch Mountains only guards personal data as long as needed for the purpose it was provided for, or for the time period stated by the law

Security

We have taken the appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your personal data against unlawful processing, among other things we have taken the following measures;

- All persons who can acquire your data on behalf of M.S.M.W.V. Dutch Mountains are bound to confidentiality;
- We handle a username and password policy on all of our systems;
- We make back-ups of personal data in order to be able to restore this information in case of a physical or technical incident;
- Our members who get in touch with personal data are made aware of the importance of the protection of personal data.

Rights about your information

You have the right of inspection, rectification and removal of the personal information we have received of you. Furthermore, you can oppose against the processing of your personal information (or a part of it) by us or one of our third parties (processors). In addition you have the right that we transmit the personal information we received from you to yourself or in your command to a third party. We could ask to legitimize yourself before we will go on with one of the above cases.

When we are allowed to process your personal information due to an agreement, you have the right to end the agreement on any time.

Complaints

In case you have complaints about our processing of your personal information, we would like to ask you to contact us directly. When we cannot agree upon each other we find this very unfortunate. You always have the right to file a complaint at the 'Autoriteit persoonsgegevens', this is the supervisory authority of privacy protection.
